As an Oral and Maxillofacial surgeon, I have been placing endosseous implants now for more than 12 years. With this in mind, I have placed implants in just about every type of autograft, allograft and xenograft bone for the reconstruction of numerous maxillofacial anatomical structures. Originally, I used nothing but Branemark, which soon became incorporated into Nobel Biocare. After numerous issues with my Nobel sales representative, I decided to change to another implant system. After several discussions with my referring doctors, it became apparent to me that the easiest transition would be a system that was compatible with Nobel. The logical choice was the Implants Direct Replant system. After performing 5 “test” cases using this system, and even waiting up to 6 months after the restoration of these implants, I decided to proceed with this system. At this point, I have placed more than 150 of these implants in just about every restorative situation imaginable, with a success rate that is as good, if not better than Nobel.
